

Bailey hosts first Aspiring Artist, Clay Hawker

Crystalbrook Bailey welcomes first Aspiring Artist, Cairns photographer Clay Hawker in March 2021.

An advocate for the arts, Bailey launched the call out for all Aspiring Artists last year before having to put a hold on exhibitions due to COVID-19. The initiative is a comprehensive arts programme giving eager, up and coming artists the opportunity to showcase their talents and have their work featured on display and for sale within the hotel gallery, with all proceeds going directly to the artist.

Local photographer Clay Hawker will be the first Aspiring Artist to exhibit his artwork at Bailey. Hawker's installation titled 'Slow Down in North Queensland' will be on display until Friday 30 April in the Bailey atrium of an evening.

The exhibition will feature 40 photographs projected on a 60 square metre wall in the hotel atrium of an evening. The collection captures the essence of Far North Queensland, from lush World Heritage Rainforest to cascading waterfalls and diverse wildlife. Bailey will host an exhibition opening and artist talk with Clay Hawker on Friday 12 March. The event will take place in the lobby from 6:30-7:30pm. Open to all, from hotel guests, locals and the Cairns arts and cultural community.

Clay Hawker said, "The northern regions of Queensland are full of stunning waterfalls, beautiful beaches, invaluable wildlife and more. What better place to unwind and savour nature? May this imagery inspire you to slow down while enjoying the great outdoors, and to encourage others to appreciate and preserve our natural assets for years to come."
