Crystalbrook Byron is leading the way with its focus on responsible luxury, saving more than 3 million plastic bottles from landfill in the past two years alone. With an infinity pool lined with daybeds (and poolside service), tennis courts and a spa, the 92-room resort hits the low-key luxury sweet spot. The suites are so private and self-contained you don't ever need to leave, however we do recommend a stroll along the lush boardwalk to Forest, the on-site restaurant headed by executive chef Jordan Staniford. And, of course, you need to experience the resort's Eléme Day Spa. Start off in the steam room then be swept away with a Bejewelled by the Sea lava-shell massage to knead out those knots.
