BAMBOO BIKES



THE RULES OF RECYCLING

Follow these simple tips to recycle like a pro!

PASS IT ON

Connect your pre-loved treasures with new homes. Find charity stores, community reuse initiatives, online forums and other local share economy ventures.

CHECK IT BEFORE YOU CHUCK IT

The Australasian Recycling Label (ARL) shows you how to dispose of all parts of your product's packaging. Look for the label today to see which parts belong in your recycling bin, the rubbish or at special recycling collection points.

KEEP IT LOOSE

When recycling, keep it out of plastic bags and put it in loose as this helps with recycling processing.

WHEN IN DOUBT, LEAVE IT OUT.

Some items can contaminate recycling such as plastic bags, food waste, clothes, window glass, batteries, mobile phones and crockery. When in doubt, leave it out. Put it in loose as this helps with recycling processing.

CHECK LOCALLY

Know what can go in your recycling bin at home. Recycle the right way when on holiday, as different councils accept different things.

BUY RECYCLED

Every time you go shopping, remember to look for products that use sustainable packaging that can be recycled, have been made from recycled materials and have a clear label that tells you how to dispose of it correctly. See what's out there – you might just see your favourite brands!
